

Number of students:

All classes will be open to a minimum of three students.

Student Show:

(For students in the Beginner 102 and 104, Intermediate 202 and 204, and Advanced Courses) Students will perform in a Student Show with all live music, where they will be able to perform with a live flamenco guitarist and singer. There are two Student Shows each year, one in January and one in May, and the particular show in which each student performs depends on the date that their flamenco course ends. The Student Shows take place at a restaurant called Vino Libro, the same restaurant that hosts Caló Gitano's monthly Professional Flamenco Show.

Class structure:

The classes are designed to teach students how to dance flamenco, not how to copy choreographed routines to pre-set music. Each class is designed to give the students the tools and techniques that they will need to dance flamenco, and to allow them to develop a thorough understanding of the dance by building on a strong foundation. The students will dance to different songs in every class, which will allow them to become more comfortable with the music associated with the particular dance that they are studying and more confident in their abilities to improvise and dance to any given song.

Recommended Attire:

Female students should wear a form fitting top, a long practice skirt, and flamenco shoes. If you are a beginner and do not have flamenco shoes, you can bring any shoes with a low heel and that cover your toes to get started, but you should make sure that the heels on the shoes are not too thin (i.e. stilettos would not be appropriate). Also, you can purchase your flamenco shoes at our Calo Gitano dance store! Male students should wear comfortable clothes that allow them to move freely. If you are a beginner and do not have flamenco boots, you can bring any dress shoes with a sole that preferably is not rubber.

Location:

Costs:

Generally each course lasts for four months, and prices vary depending on the course you are taking. Students who pay for the entire course up front receive a discount. Class payments are not refundable, and students are responsible for paying the costs of the entire course even when paying in installment. The registration for your course will not be complete until you have paid, in advance, for the first two months of class. The payment for the the third month is due no later than the first day of the second month of class. The third and final payment is due no later than the first day of the third month of class, ensuring that you have fulfilled all of your payment obligations one month before the course is completed.
